THE PURPOSEFUL MINISTER

- Evangelist Toyin Fatunsin

Ephesians 4:10-12:

He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.) And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the [a] edifying of the body of Christ.

Purpose is the reason we are created and how it gives meaning to what we do.

Whether ordained or not, everyone is called for a purpose. Ministry isn't limited to the church; there are missionaries and ministers serving in various places.

The Bible mentions the fivefold ministry—apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers—who are called to equip and build up the body of Christ. In ministry training, we often use our five fingers to represent these roles. But being called into one of these ministries isn't for recognition or titles—it's a calling to service. God wants us to understand that our calling is not for titles, but for building up the saints.

Some may have titles such as deaconess or serve as heads of departments. But the essence of ministry is not in the title; it's in understanding the purpose behind it. As Ephesians 4:12 put it, it is for the perfecting of the saints, for building the body of Christ.

So, as ministers, we are called to build up—to build up our departments, the body of Christ, and each other. Whether you are a deaconess, pastor's wife, or serving in another capacity, your role is to contribute to the building of the church.

Explaining the fivefold ministry through our five fingers:

- The small finger represents the teachers. They help break down the Word of God, explaining it in detail, just like Sunday School

teachers do.

- The ring finger symbolizes pastors. Pastors “marry” us to Jesus. They encourage us, support us, and draw us closer to God.

- The middle finger stands for evangelists. Evangelists preach the message of salvation without compromise—they declare the truth, telling people plainly: “Receive Jesus, or you will face eternal judgment.”

- The index finger represents the prophets. They convey the mind of God, declaring, “Thus says the Lord.”

- Finally, the thumb symbolizes the apostles. They are the leaders who oversee and guide the work of the ministry.

Unfortunately, today, many take on titles without understanding their true calling. Some switch between pastor, apostle, and prophet, not knowing where they belong. But ministry is not about titles; it's about fulfilling the purpose God has placed on our lives. You don't need a title to serve the Lord.

So, what does it mean to have a purposeful ministry? First, it means understanding that you are called to build up and work together with the called. A prophet cannot say you don't need a pastor, and a pastor cannot disregard the evangelist. We are all part of one body, working together for a common goal.

When I started ministry as an evangelist preaching and winning souls through drama and the word, some people asked, “What happens after someone accepts Christ? Isn't this work wasted if you don't have a church to build them up?” I told them, my part is to lead people to

Christ, and it's the church's role to nurture them afterward. Ministry is about teamwork—Paul planted, Apollos watered, but it is God who gives the increase.

Purposeful ministry means knowing your calling and place in the body of Christ. Ordination confirms the calling, but it does not define it. Jeremiah 1:5 tells us that God knew us and ordained us before we were born. The oil of ordination is a confirmation of the calling, not the beginning of it.

Unfortunately, some are ordained without fully understanding what they're being ordained for. Ordination should confirm what God has already spoken to you. So, before accepting ordination, ensure you understand your role and the doctrine of the ministry where you are ordained.

Ministry is not about people serving you; it's about you are serving God and His people. We are called to serve, not to be served. We must understand that leadership in ministry means serving others, just as Elisha served Elijah (2 Kings 3:11). Elisha was known as the one who poured water on Elijah's hands, yet he carried a double portion of Elijah's spirit. His focus wasn't on Elijah's weaknesses but on fulfilling God's purpose.

In ministry, we may see the weaknesses of our leaders, but we must remain focussed and loyal to the calling. Familiarity can rob us of the grace our leaders carry. It's essential to respect those in authority, even if they are younger than you, because grace and calling are what matters.

In purposeful ministry, we must remain loyal to our assignment, our calling, and our ministry. Some people don't know who their spiritual parents are, jumping from one leader to another. But loyalty and commitment are vital. Be faithful to the vision and mission of your ministry.

As women in ministry, it's also essential to carry our husbands along. The Shunammite woman (2

Kings 4:8-10) is a great example. Even though she was the one who had the revelation, she involved her husband in the process. If your husband is not in ministry, still involve him in your decisions. Be open and transparent, as it fosters unity.

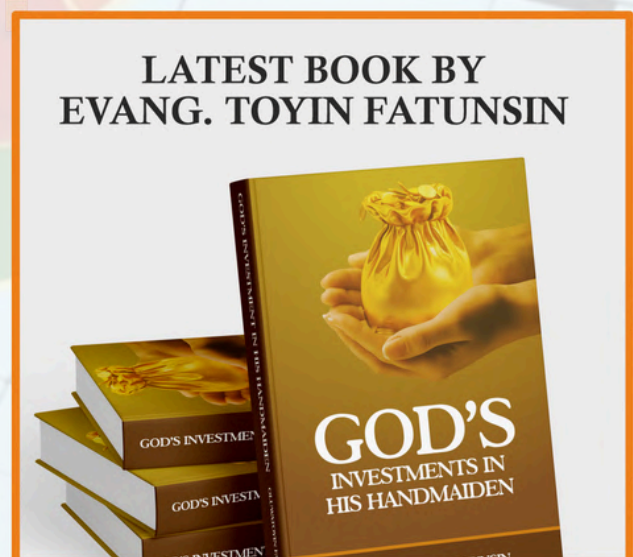
Maintaining a clean testimony in ministry. Our conduct must be above reproach, both morally and spiritually. Avoid scandals and maintain integrity. A clear testimony is crucial—whether in financial matters, relationships, or how we carry ourselves in ministry.

To summarize, purposeful ministry means:

- Knowing your calling and purpose.
- Serving faithfully, whether through leadership or as a helper.
- Loyalty to the calling and the vision of your ministry.
- Maintaining a clean testimony, avoiding anything that could bring dishonor to your ministry.

Let us not grow weary in doing good, for in due time, we will reap the harvest if we don't give up (Galatians 6:9). God sees and rewards His faithful servants, and even if people don't say "thank you," God always does.

May God bless us all as we continue to serve Him purposefully, in Jesus' name. Amen

Theme **KEY SCRIPTURE**

Number 27:1 - 11

Then came the daughters of Zelophehad the son of Hopher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, from the families of Manasseh the son of Joseph; and these were the names of his daughters: Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah. 2 And they stood before Moses, before Eleazar the priest, and before the leaders and all the congregation, by the doorway of the tabernacle of meeting, saying: 3 "Our father died in the wilderness; but he was not in the company of those who gathered together against the LORD, in company with Korah, but he died in his own sin; and he had no sons. 4 Why should the name of our father be removed[a] from among his family because he had no son? Give us a [b]possession among our father's brothers." 5 So Moses brought their case before the LORD.

6 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: 7 "The daughters of Zelophehad speak what is right; you shall surely give them a possession of inheritance among their father's brothers, and cause the inheritance of their father to pass to them. 8 And you shall speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'If a man dies and has no son, then you shall cause his inheritance to pass to his daughter. 9 If he has no daughter, then you shall give his inheritance to his brothers. 10 If he has no brothers, then you shall give his inheritance to his father's brothers. 11 And if his father has no brothers, then you shall give his inheritance to

the relative closest to him in his family, and he shall possess it.' " And it shall be to the children of Israel a statute of.

This was a joint effort by the daughters of Zelophehad. They all came together in agreement and came before Moses, Eleazar, the leaders and congregation together to ask to be given a possession among their father's brothers and cause their father's inheritance to be given to them. They had unity of purpose, coming together to tread new ground that had never been tread before. Up till now, what they were asking for had never been done. They came by virtue of being their father's daughters in unity. Just as we are daughters of the King of kings. Matthew 18:19-20

19 "Again[a] I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. 20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them." Dear Female Pastors and Pastors wives how do we go about the task of taking over or taking charge together with our husbands and with others that God has called to work together with.

If you are a Pastor's wife or Pastoring along with your husband, God wants you to work together with your husband to see God's Kingdom advance. God brought you together for a purpose. You are his helpmate called to surround him with your help, using the gifts God has given you to see souls saved, disciples made and matured, and the Church grow.

If you are female Pastor, the ladies the Lord has put around you are there for you to work with to see His Kingdom established and extended.

– PASTOR COMFORT ADEJUMO

In Joppa, there was a disciple named Tabitha, also known as Dorcas. She was known for her good work and charitable deeds. However, during those days, she became ill and passed away. After preparing her body, the disciples laid her in an upper room. Since Lydda was near Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent two men to him, pleading with him to come quickly. Peter immediately rose and went with them. When he arrived, they took him to the upper room, where Dorcas' body was laid. The widows stood around Peter, weeping and showing him the tunics and garments Dorcas had made while she was with them. Peter, however, asked everyone to leave the room, knelt, and prayed. He then turned to the body and said, "Tabitha, arise." She opened her eyes, saw Peter, and sat up. Peter took her by the hand, lifted her up, and called the saints and widows to present her alive. Acts 9:36-41

The story of Dorcas reminds us that our work will speak for us. The Bible tells us that God will judge our works. As a person of value, your impact should be felt, and you should be missed when you're not around. Each of us has been uniquely designed to fulfill a purpose, and no one can do what you do quite like you. Therefore, whatever talent or task God has entrusted to you, do it wholeheartedly, as unto the Lord. Don't expect human recognition or reward, as your ultimate reward comes from

God.

The parable of the talents illustrates this truth. One man was given five talents, another two, and another one. When the master returned, he asked what they had done with what they had been given. Are we making use of the talents God has entrusted to us? Every gift He has given is meant to be used for His glory.

There is a reward for every faithful minister. It's a reward that money cannot buy. I am a living testimony to this. I remember a time when I needed to buy shoes for my son after church. However, I was delayed by some responsibilities at church and felt I had let my son down. No one knew about the shoes, but when I got home, I found that someone had bought brand-new designer shoes for him. I was overwhelmed with joy and gratitude to God for providing through a stranger.

As valued ministers, we must place God first in all we do and ensure we handle the responsibilities given to us with excellence. God knows our limitations, and He makes a way for us. Was Jacob's service in vain? No, God rewarded him.

As a minister, it's also important to take time for rest. Going on holidays to refresh yourself allows you to return to your duties with renewed energy and joy. When you are away, your value should be missed. Remember, it's the use of your talents that adds value to your life, not the rewards or recognition from pastors or leaders. So, use your talents well, for the glory of God.

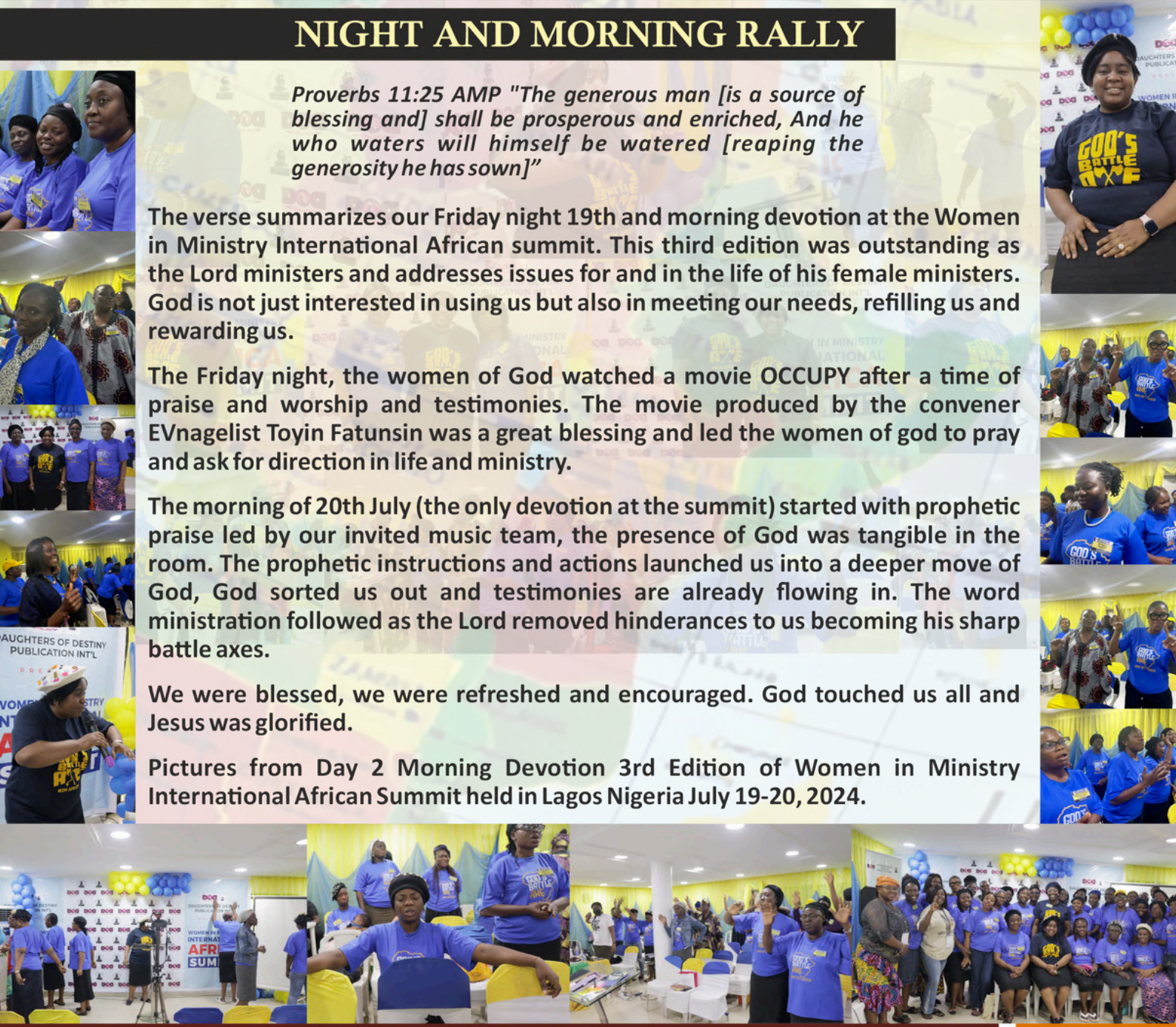

A SANCTIFIED MINISTER

(Text: 1 Thessalonians 4:3-4)

A solid foundation is required for a building that will endure strong wind or storm. However, a building with weak foundation cannot withstand adversity or storm. In the same vein, a believer especially, a minister of God must have a solid foundation in God in order to fulfill and complete the assignment the Lord has committed in her hand.

Throughout the Bible, there are many vessels who were either strong or weak in faith and the impacts they made. In this conference, the Lord wants to do something afresh in your life and in the ministry, He has committed into your hands. You will not fail in Jesus name.

1) BUILDING BLOCK OF A MINISTER

Psalms 11:3, 1 Corinthians 4:2, Colossians 4:17, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Romans 10:13

Who is a Minister? A minister is someone who has received the gift of salvation from the Lord, called and chosen to carry out the great mandate from the Lord. She has forsaken sin, world and the devil through genuine repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

A minister does the work of her Master through sacrifice and the desire to bring glory to God. She is selfless in her service, submissive to God's word and sincere to God and people.

"Moreover, it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful." (1 Corinthians 4:2)

What does God require from you? Faithfulness!

Wherever you are or whatever you do, God requires faithfulness.

The devil will suggest taking wrong approach but your determination to remain faithful to God no matter what is the key to a fulfilled ministry.



2) SANCTIFICATION : CIRCUMCISION OF HEART

Matthew 5:8, Hebrews 12:14, 1 Thessalonians 4:3, Deuteronomy 30:6

Apart from your service to God, God still desires you to go higher and love Him more. Your relationship with Him means a lot and that will determine the level you will go in ministry. However, the adamic nature must be

uprooted and that is what sanctification does. There is need for the circumcision of the heart whereby a believer cries out to God to uproot every trace of adamic nature and to love Him more.

The believer must pray in faith and stay close to God in prayer and diligent study of the Word. This is not a license to be careless but keep watching against the wiles of the devil. Holy

living is paramount and a must if a believer wants to get to heaven and offer worthy service to God. "Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord" (Hebrews 12:14)

To follow peace with all men can only be done by God's grace and deep love for God through this experience. You will meet people of different characters who may want to hinder your fellowship with God. This holiness of life will help you to love and relate with them like Jesus. In addition, more of the secrets of God's kingdom will be revealed to you in order to run the race effectively.

3) THE LIFESTYLE OF AN EMPOWERED MINISTER

Romans 12:1 - 2, John 15:4 - 5, Acts 1:8, Micah 3:8, 1 Corinthians 11:1, 1 John 3:18

Without the power of the Holy Ghost, a believer can't do anything meaningful in the ministry. To go far in the ministry God has committed into your hands, you need the power of God (Acts 1:8).

The Holy Ghost will help you to do the work of the ministry according to God's will. You will achieve more and go extra mile in the ministry to impact lives and glorify God.

Desire Him, ask in faith, be expectant, stand on God's promises and pray until you are endued from on high. Be open to God and follow Him all the way. He will use you as a mighty instrument in His hand to set the captives free and bring glory to God.

9) She supports her husband and cares for her home. (Proverbs 31:27 - 28)

10) She supports her church growth and influences others to be what God wants them to be. (Hebrews 13:1, 2 Timothy 1:6 - 7)
